- Capacity to play alone
- Imagination
- Exposure to stories (reading to your child)

Behaviour control

- Impulsive behaviour
- Oppositional
- Frustration

Attention control

- Concentration span on required and challenging activities

Emotional control

- Fears / anxieties / shyness
- Anger control
- Excitability

Organisation

- Routines at home
- Routines at school

Language

Expressive (talking)

- Vocabulary
- Verbal concepts (e.g. personal pronouns)
- Grammar / sentences
- Putting sentences together into stories

Receptive (listening)

- Paying attention
- Comprehension
- Memory

Speech / articulation

- Poor articulation,
- Stutter / dysfluency

Gross Motor

- Coordination of specific activities (e.g. bike riding, gymnastics, climbing)
- Physical strength, fitness / endurance
- Coordination of ball sports

Fine Motor

- Manipulation skills (e.g. Buttons)
- Early pencil use, drawing, colouring

Self care

- Sleep
- Eating / feeding
- Exercise
- Dressing
- Media habits (TV, video games, internet)
- Toilet training
- Personal hygiene

Learning

School readiness (if appropriate)

- Letter / number recognition
- Writing / letter and number formation
- Colours, shapes
- Puzzles / problem solving

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
